Letter FROM THE PRINCIPAL

I first learned of Chapelle in 1979 when I moved into the area. The big school I passed frequently while running errands up and down Veterans was much larger than the one I had left in Ascension Parish. I applied and interviewed a couple of weeks before school was scheduled to begin. While I applied for an English position, I was hired for social studies because I had a minor in it and had more college credits in that area than any other applicant. I was terrified of our assistant principal, Sr. Aquilina. I was too afraid to call in sick. In time I came to appreciate her wicked sense of humor and her ability to quickly summarize a complex battle sequence. She made me a better teacher. It was the beginning of a beautiful relationship. Of the 24 new teachers who began with me, only two others remain—Bonnie Sheppard and Jane Ann Frosch.

During my thirty years at Chapelle, I grew as a teacher while teaching some of you American history, world history, and civics. As junior and senior sponsor, I worked with Rally, ordered sweaters and rings, and organized proms. In the 1990s, I picked up Advanced Placement American history which proved to be both challenging and rewarding. In 1985 I became the social studies department chairperson, maintaining that position until 2001, when I took on the position of Director of Student Life. In 2004 I joined the administration as Assistant Principal for Staff Development and began working with teachers on curriculum and methodology. Along the way, my colleagues became my friends, and my students became adults, parents of today's Chipmunks.

In July, 2009 I started a new phase of my professional life, that of principal. People often ask what I think of my job. It's an important job that defies definition. In the course of my day, I am counselor, disciplinarian, comforter, collaborator, judge, objective listener, voice of reason, coercer, and affirmer. While my day is busy it is never boring. I go home tired but happy.

Chapelle has become a home to me. The love and support I have received from my Chapelle family have carried me through rough times. They have been with me through the good, the bad, and the ugly. To paraphrase a song, I am better because I have known them.

Faculty Spotlight

Mrs. Brenda Capaci is a very outgoing and well-known teacher at Archbishop Chapelle High School. She has been teaching in the parochial school system for thirty-nine years and has been a member of the Chapelle faculty for thirty-seven years. Mrs. Capaci has enjoyed her many years at Chapelle, where she teaches a variety of business, finance, and computer classes for all grade levels.

Over the years, Mrs. Capaci has witnessed many changes at Chapelle, such as different uniforms, longer class periods, and technological advancements. Yet, despite these changes, Mrs. Capaci recognized that one thing still remains the same, and that is the spirit of Chapelle. She said, "Chapelle remains a constant family atmosphere, making it a great place to work as well as learn."

More than anyone, Mrs. Capaci should feel at home at Chapelle, since she works here with her daughter, her husband and her sister. Her daughter, Mrs. Stacy Woodward, is a computer teacher and works right across the hall from her mother. They both teach Computer Applications I, which gives them the chance to work closely with one another.

When asked about her daughter, Mrs. Capaci said, "I'm very proud of her as a teacher, a dance moderator, mom, wife...and daughter." Mrs. Capaci's husband, Deacon Drea Capaci, is the co-chaplain at Chapelle. While talking about him, she said, "He's my best friend! He's the person I most want to spend time with. I especially like to attend the Communion service on Tuesday mornings at school. Because deacons are active on the altar, we seldom have the privilege of sitting in the pew together for church services. I'm really proud of him, and I try to support him in prayer whenever he is serving at Mass." Mrs. Capaci also works with her sister, Mrs. Beth Mares, who the tennis coach and a member of the support staff.

In addition to teaching, Mrs. Capaci shares her gifts and talents with the students of Chapelle. One way she does this is by playing the piano during school liturgies. Mrs. Capaci said that she received her first piano at the age of five, and according to her mother, she started playing that day. Over the years, she has played at parish Masses and many weddings and funerals. Mrs. Capaci also teaches private piano lessons.

Mrs. Capaci is a gift to Chapelle and the students she has taught over the years, and we honor and thank her for everything she has done for our Chapelle family.
