Thank you all for your continued patience and understanding as we navigate these uncertain times. We continue to seek guidance from the Office of Catholic Schools and received the following statement from the Archdiocese of New Orleans earlier today:

In light of Governor Edwards' closure of all public schools for the remainder of the school year, the Office of Catholic Schools, in consultation with Archbishop Aymond and Catholic School leaders, is evaluating all options to bring the school year to a close. While it is highly unlikely we will have the ability to return to normal session, we are hopeful that we will be able to work with school communities to bring closure to their school year, particularly for our graduating seniors and 7th graders.

Please rest assured that we will disseminate additional information as soon as it becomes available. In light of these circumstances, I continue to stand amazed at the level of commitment of our entire Chapelle community. Our students have adapted quickly to this new way of day to day instruction and continue to excel. And just like so many of our families, our teachers are trying to balance educating their own children or tending to other pressing needs while putting in countless hours ensuring that our students receive the best Catholic education possible.
