### WHAT TO BRING TO APPLICATION DAY

- 2 sharpened #2 pencils with erasers (*No calculators or mechanical pencils*)
- A jacket or sweater as room temperatures vary

### GENERAL INFORMATION

- The dress for application day is dressy casual—no shorts or ripped jeans
- Check in will begin at 7:30AM in the cafeteria.
- 7:30AM - 8:30AM - donuts, milk, and coffee will be provided for students and parents in the cafeteria.
- 7:50AM - students will be escorted from the cafeteria to their assigned classrooms (*Parents are welcome to stay to 8:30AM*)
- 8:00AM - 11:30AM – test will be conducted
- 11:30AM - parents must park to pick up their daughter from the cafeteria.

### FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS FOR APPLICANTS

- How are my scores from the High School Placement Test utilized?  
Results from the High School Placement Test are utilized as standardized testing scores for the admissions process, qualifying scores for the scholarship program, and, if a student is accepted, for class schedule placement.
- When will I receive my scores?  
Results from the High School Placement Test will be included in acceptance notification mailings at the conclusion of your Admissions process.
- How can I prepare for the High School Placement Test?  
There are practice tests available online, however, the best preparation for this exam is for the applicant to get a good night's sleep and eat a healthy breakfast!

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## SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Qualifying National Percentages are taken from the ACT Aspire taken in 6th Grade or the High School Placement Test taken in January 2023.

### SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

#### Acorn Scholarship

To be eligible for a scholarship, a student must:

- Achieve a National Percentile of 90%-99% on the High School Placement Test taken in January 2021
- Be an incoming 8th grade student
- Follow the regular application process and timeline
- Have only As & Bs on her report card for 5<sup>th</sup> grade, 6<sup>th</sup> grade, and the entirety of 7<sup>th</sup> grade
- Maintain exemplary conduct in 5<sup>th</sup> grade, 6<sup>th</sup> grade, and the entirety of 7<sup>th</sup> grade

Deus Providebit Scholarship                      99% = Full Tuition

Our Lady of Prompt Succor Scholarship      98%-97% = 3/4 Tuition Reduction

Incarnate Word Scholarship                    96%-95% = 1/2 Tuition Reduction

Loyal to Green and White Scholarship      94%-93% = 1/4 Tuition Reduction

Chipmunk Scholarship                          92%-91% = \$1,000

Acorn Scholarship                                90% = \$500

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## BONNIE SHEPPARD MEMORIAL LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

At Archbishop Chapelle High School, we value student leaders. Chapelle students are encouraged to become fully immersed in campus life, through involvement in clubs, teams, honor societies, and service groups.

At Chapelle, a student leader positively impacts those around her through displays of kindness and respect. She dedicates herself to her school community and recognizes her worth in making a difference.

The Chapelle Community is pleased to offer Leadership Scholarships for the 2020-2021 school year. Applicants for this scholarship must meet the following criteria:

- Be an incoming 8<sup>th</sup> grade student currently enrolled in a Catholic, private, homeschool, or public elementary school
- Involvement in at least one club, team, or service group in their current grammar school, church parish, or community
- Maintain exemplary attendance and disciplinary conduct in grammar school
- Maintain above a C average in grammar school
- Receive a favorable recommendation from current school administrator
- **Submit printed scholarship essays at Prospective Student Interviews.**

**Applicants will complete a typed, 250-word essay in MLA format on the following prompt:**  
What are the qualities of an effective leader and how do you exhibit these traits in your own life? Give specific examples of times you displayed these leadership qualities.

Applicants will be reviewed by a scholarship committee composed of graduates of Archbishop Chapelle High School. Scholarship winners are notified of their awards on Friday, February 17.

*The Archbishop Chapelle High School Leadership Scholarship is funded by the Bonnie Sheppard Memorial Endowment. Sheppard began her career as a teacher at Chapelle in 1979 and her personality, described as the essence of school spirit, made her the perfect fit to be the Student Council moderator from 1988-2014. She touched the lives of many students over the 36 years she taught at Chapelle, inspiring students to lead others through charismatic service.*

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
